This four-piece system can be disassembled and moved by two people in under five minutes. Best of all, this system offers the same reliability and ease of use that have made Brownell Lumber Company docks the primary choice in this area for over forty years. Gone are the days of watching as your dock is damaged or destroyed by being frozen in or washed ashore. Dock owners can now conveniently store their system in the safest location when not in use.

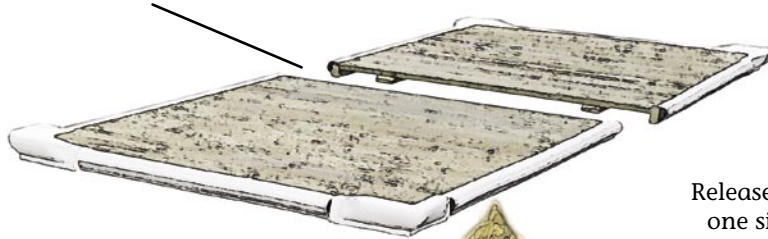




The Float n' Tote Dock System™ – comprised of a two-piece deck system, an outer shell, and an inner floatation module – can be assembled or disassembled in under five minutes. The Float n' Tote is available in nine sizes, ranging from 4' x 8' to 8' x 16'. The system is modular, so you can attach multiple docks together to facilitate a system of any length. The Float n' Tote is as light as aluminum docks, but without the warping, hot surfaces, and noise associated with metal. Instead, the system is built from arsenic-free pressure-treated dimensional lumber for years of reliable service. The floatation module utilizes fuel and mildew-resistant Dow® Floatation Billets, the same floatation used in our docks for over twenty years.

Disassembly is just a few easy steps, and can be done in under five minutes with two people.

- >> **1** Lift off each individual deck panel after releasing the quick-release cleat mechanism.



>> **2**

- Release the custom ratchet lever on one side of the floatation module.



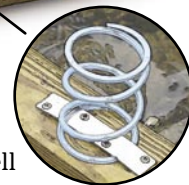
>> **3**

- Remove the two quick-release pins from the opposite end.



>> **4**

- The spring system will push the floatation module up out of the shell to allow for easy removal, eliminating pinched fingers and skinned knuckles. Remove the floatation module, and then move the outer shell.
